Guyart began fencing in at the young age of five when his father introduced him to the sport. Athens marked his first time competing at the Olympics. In 2001, Guyart took home first place in fencing at the World Championships. When he is not practicing, Guyart enjoys surfing, skateboarding, and data processing.



At this years' Olympic games, France ranked 7th in gold medals, winning a total of 11. In addition, French athletes took home 9 silvers, 13 bronze. A total of 33!
