All documents submitted for application to the Sport Management Program for admission for Fall 2008 must be received by the March 1st, 2008 deadline to be considered a complete application. In the case of the GPA, this will be calculated on the grades earned at the time of application and also and the end of the spring semester. Initial acceptance decisions are contingent upon the student's GPA at the end of the spring semester. Should a student's overall GPA fall below the level when initially accepted, the Department has the right to deny this student admission.

We are pleased to hear of your interest in the Sport Management program at Florida State University. The Department of Sport Management, Recreation Management, and Physical Education is proud of the program which is recognized for the quality and preparation of its graduates for the sport industry. Because of the high demand for admission to the Sport Management program, admission is on a competitive basis. Only a limited number of students will be admitted to the program and admissions will occur one time during the year. This will guarantee the continuation of a high level of quality in all areas of teaching, and student participation in the classroom. Please note that admission to Florida State University does not automatically make a student eligible for admission to the Sport Management Program.

In order to facilitate the admission of qualified students to the program, the department reviews applications submitted by **March 1st 2008 for admission to the Fall 2008 term. No students will be admitted for the Spring or Summer term.** In addition to submitting an application to the Sport Management program, students also need to complete and submit an application for admission to the College of Education. Students with the highest GPA as well as all required coursework will have top priority for admission. Students otherwise meeting the minimum admission requirements (2.50 GPA) will be held until the end of the application period. The admissions committee will consider all the information submitted in making admission decisions. Students with the minimum GPA are welcome to apply but are not guaranteed admission. In addition to GPA, the number of students admitted is heavily based on Departmental resources. The program typically admits 70 students annually. Materials are

The Undergraduate Program in Sport Management

The undergraduate program in Sport Management is designed to provide students with both the academic foundation necessary to successfully continue on to a graduate degree in Sport Administration or to take an entry-level position in the sport industry. The program is continuously refined to aligning the curriculum with the standards forwarded by the North American Society of Sport Management (NASSM).

There are four features of the Florida State University program in Sport Management that are unique. First, the Program is identified as "limited enrollment." Only a specified number of the best-qualified students are admitted once a year. While a few of the "foundations courses" may have large enrollments, the courses in the major are limited in size. Second, students have the opportunity to obtain valuable job related work experience via an internship. The Program's philosophy is based upon a balance between theory and practical application. Students will have significant opportunities to apply what they have learned in class to working in various sport organizations. Third, the courses in the Program are arranged into four "blocks." Students will have the same classmates in all of their "block" courses. Students have the opportunity to forge personal and professional relationships, which may last throughout their careers. Because students register in "blocks," there is no difficulty registering for the required courses. Space in all courses is guaranteed once a student is admitted into the Program. Finally, the course curriculum allows the student the flexibility to select elective courses that are geared towards a greater understanding of a particular subject area.
