HEADS UP! WHEN AT THE CROSSWALK

- Look up from your phone and pay attention when approaching a crosswalk.
- Cross the street at marked crosswalks and intersections.
- Make sure vehicles come to a complete stop before you cross.
- Wear bright or reflective clothing at night so drivers can see you.
- Use pedestrian push buttons and obey walk and don't walk signals.

HEADS UP! WHILE DRIVING

- Never text and drive.
- Be prepared to stop for pedestrians at all crosswalks and intersections.
- To avoid rushing leave 15 min. early.
- Obey the speed limit at all times.
- Don't pass a vehicle that is stopped at a crosswalk for a pedestrian.
